When people flee domestic violence they often need help with transportation expenses to get to a safe place or meet with a WRAP advocate.

\$50-Basic Needs

When people flee domestic violence they often leave everything behind. WRAP provides items such as diapers & wipes, toothpaste, laundry soap, clothing, etc.

\$100-Safe Shelter & food for 1 night

When people are fleeing, they often need a safe place to stay until they can work with a WRAP advocate and make long-term plans.

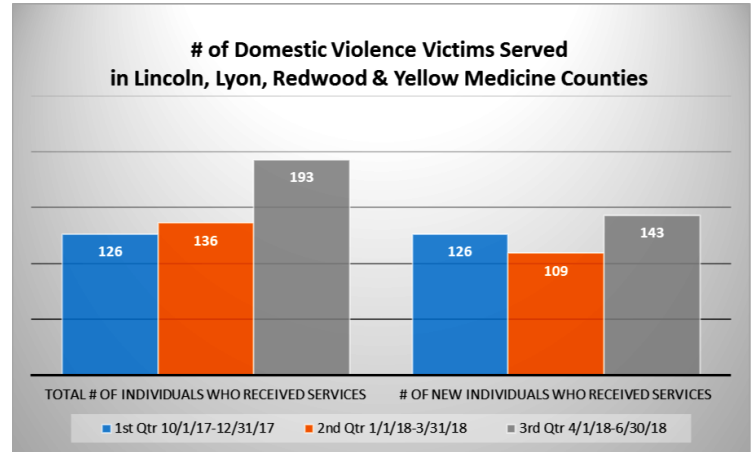
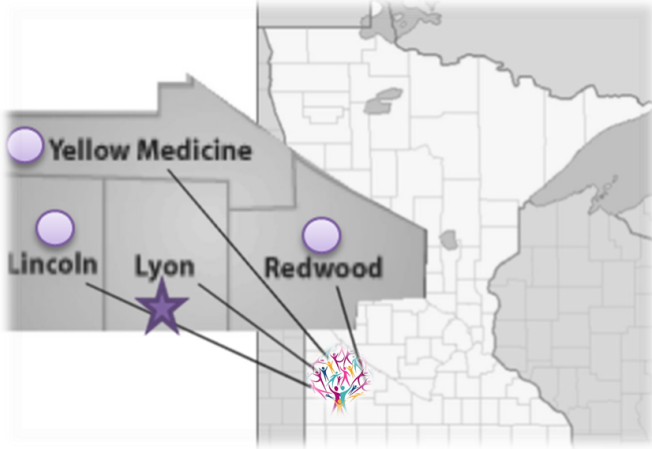
WHY SHOULD YOU GET INVOLVED?

HOW IT WORKS

2. Each team will fill out a registration form and return it back to WRAP.
3. Each team will be given a change can to collect donations in (coins, paper money, checks).
4. Now comes the easy part! Place the can where people can see it like on a counter, by a register, in an employee lounge, on your desk, etc. Any place there is a lot of traffic!
5. The competition beginning October 1st and ending on October 31st. The collection can will be returned back to WRAP at the beginning of November.
